

Chesapeake Research Consortium C-StREAM Internship Application

Note: This application is only for positions at EPA Chesapeake Bay Program Office and NOAA Chesapeake Bay Office. The deadline for applying for positions at research universities has passed. Thank you for your interest in the Chesapeake Student Recruitment, Early Advisement, and Mentoring (C-StREAM) internship/fellowship program. This program provides financial support (stipend and housing) for summer experiences with Chesapeake Bay Program partnering institutions to undergraduate students at all levels (rising sophomore through post-Baccalaureate), with preference to promising applicants from typically under-represented populations who wish to explore management or academic careers in environmental restoration, protection, and management, particularly as related to estuarine systems and their watersheds. The summer will be spent at a host institution working closely with a mentor on a research project. Once funded for summer internship, the student becomes a C-StREAM Fellow who is eligible for future support and mentorship. In this regard, we ask applicants to identify, if possible, a faculty member at the home institution who is willing to serve after the internship is complete as a point of contact and (ideally) proactive mentor for the student's development as a researcher. The application should be submitted electronically by April 9th, 2019. Letters of recommendation should be uploaded directly by recommenders by April 16th.

For your application to be complete you must also **submit by March 1**st, **2019**, the following additional required materials:

- 1 page cover letter (<500 words), including an overview of your background and motivation for applying to this internship.
- Ranked position choices (Word document explaining the positions, with your choices ranked)
- 1-2 page statement of interest (500-1500 words), including separate sections about (a) longer-term interests; (b) how your involvement in the C-StREAM program would contribute to your career goals; and (c) how your background, experiences, and/or intended career will contribute to diversity and improved inclusivity within academic, management, and/or other professional careers in environmental restoration, protection, and management. If you are applying to an REU or other internship at a CRC member institution please also provide that information in your statement of interest.
- Resumé
- College transcripts (official or "released to student")
- Letters of recommendation should be submitted directly by the recommenders through the CRC online portal. It is the applicant's obligation to make this request of recommenders well in advance of the deadline and to remind them if necessary.

NOTE 1: Recommenders should be informed to discuss their relationship to the applicant (how they know them) and to address, to the fullest extent they are able, the applicant's motivation and drive, work ethic, sense of personal responsibility and accountability, ability to work well in teams, and leadership skills.

NOTE 2: If possible, one letter should be from a person who can confirm her/his commitment a role as follow-up point-of-contact/mentor. At the level of rising senior or above, such a letter is critically important to successful application. For others, it is a "plus." In all cases, the CRC will work with candidates to identify and contact a home institution mentor prior to making the award.
